Target Groups: Personnel from Ankara Bar Association Gelincik Centre, civil society organizations (CSOs) active in women's issues, academics, judicial and security staff, lawyers, prosecutors, gendarme and municipality personnel, personnel from Ankara Bar Association Violence Prevention and Monitoring Centre (ŞÖNİM), members of the media and local citizens

Project Aim: The project "Capacity Building for Monitoring Judicial Data in Combating Violence against Women" aims to strengthen monitoring capacity in effective implementation of the Law no. 6284 in combating violence against women, advocacy capacity of stakeholders, and awareness of existing legal support mechanisms so as to contribute to the prevention of violence against women.

The project is financed by the European Union under the CEİDizler Grant Programme. Through the project activities:

- A data monitoring and evaluation model will be developed in combating violence along with training of relevant stakeholders in indicator-based data monitoring and evaluation,
- In line with indicators identified, data will be selected and reported from 2,500 applications made to the Youth Centre of Ankara Bar Association on cases of violence against women in the period 2017-2021,
- An advocacy strategy will be developed to build capacity in stakeholders together with training in advocacy,
- Cooperation and coordination workshop will be organized with local and national stakeholders.

Project's Main Expected Result: Increased capacity in collecting and monitoring legal data concerning violence against women and in advocacy for legal mechanisms in combating violence against women; awareness of the functionality of existing legislation in this respect, and advanced institutional cooperation.

Achievements Gained through Project Outputs: The extent to which women victims of violence can find support when they resort to existing legal mechanisms and actual effectiveness of the Law no. 6284 in preventing violence will be examined through data collection and compilation and the outcome will be reported. There will be in-depth interviews with 10 women victims of violence for data collection purposes. Besides, in addition to capacity building trainings on data collection and advocacy, a workshop will be organized to enhance cooperation and coordination among stakeholders and data obtained from the project will be shared through relevant platforms. Also, there will be a report on international best practices in collecting administrative data related to combatting violence against women.
