Target Groups: 10 municipalities wich Local Equality Action Plans are to be monitored (Ankara Metropolitan Municipality, Ankara Yenimahalle, Ankara Çankaya, Samsun Atakum, Eskisehir Metropolitan Municipality, Bursa Nilufer, Istanbul Kadikoy, Izmir Metropolitan Municipality, Antalya Muratpasa and Tunceli Municipalities), municipality personnel to take training in indicator-based monitoring, gender equality and local equality action plan development to monitor gender equality, monitoring board members to take training in rights-based monitoring, and local citizens.

Project Aim: The project "Platform for Digital Monitoring of Local Equality Action Plans" aims to ensure the implementation of local equality action plans developed by municipalities in Türkiye from the perspective of gender equality and rights-based monitoring and evaluation with the participation of civil society organizations (CSOs).

The project is financed by the European Union under the CEİDizler Grant Programme. Through the project activities:

- 10 participating municipalities will be assisted in developing Indicator-based and Monitorable Local Equality Action Plans,
- A digital monitoring system will be established to monitor Local Equality Action Plans,
- An izleme.org website will be launched to make all project activities accessible,
- There will be guidelines for the use of digital monitoring system to support the development of Local Equality Action Plans,

- There will be capacity building trainings for municipalities and the monitoring board,
- There will be online and in-person technical monitoring to ensure the regular monitoring of Municipal Local Equality Action Plans,
- Experience sharing meetings will be organized to promote best practices by municipalities.

Project's Main Expected Result: Ensuring rights-based, transparent, and accessible monitoring of local equality action plans of participating municipalities in cooperation with CSOs from different fields of expertise in gender and rights-based monitoring and enhanced culture of cooperation and solidarity between municipalities and CSOs.

Achievements Gained through Project Outputs: It will be ensured that Local Equality Action Plans prepared by municipalities on the basis of their training in capacity building are rights-based, monitorable and indicator-based. This will produce Local Equality Action Plans by 10 municipalities based on the work of the monitoring board and cooperation between CSOs and municipalities. Progress reports prepared under the project will make it possible to assess the present state of municipalities and areas which need improvement. Digital tools will be developed to monitor the system and Local Equality Action Plans. Best practices from different municipalities will be disseminated through experience-sharing meetings along with improved cooperation between municipalities.
