Target Groups: Senior officials in district municipalities of Arakli, Besikduzu, Surmene, and Salpazari of Trabzon as the project province, representatives of local equality desks in district municipalities, local women leaders and citizens.

Project Aim: The project “Lasting Traces” aims to enhance institutional capacity in Trabzon and mentioned districts in strengthening local equality mechanisms, developing local equality action plans for urban services, implementing indicator-based gender equality monitoring plans, and in delivering gender-responsive services.

The project is financed by the European Union under the CEİDizler Grant Programme. Through the project activities:

- Local equality mechanisms will be strengthened in Trabzon and in relevant districts,
- Indicator-based gender equality monitoring plans will be implemented by developing local equality action plans through monitoring commissions in the context of urban services and institutional capacity in gender-sensitive service delivery will be strengthened,
- Capacity of women’s CSOs in advocacy of rights and organization will be enhanced along with qualitative and quantitative improvements in services extended to women, and project outputs will be extended to 18 districts in Trabzon province.

Project’s Main Expected Result: Local women’s rights coordination and monitoring boards will be established in the related districts. The expected result is to have local equality action plans and monitoring plans developed with high level of participation and accordingly to serve as a positive model for the remaining 14 districts.

Achievements Gained through Project Outputs: The local equality mechanism introduced in relevant districts earlier by the Trabzon Metropolitan Municipality but remained inactive will be made operational. Institutional capacity of district municipalities in extending services for women’s empowerment will be improved through capacity building trainings. Women’s rights coordination boards will be established in districts and local equality action plans will be developed to support women’s empowerment. Indicator-based gender equality monitoring work will be carried out by establishing district-level monitoring commissions. Boards and commissions established to ensure the sustainability of the project will be designed in a way to ensure women’s empowerment. In relation to mechanisms and activities taking place under the project, there will be cooperation with Trabzon Governorate and Local Equality Units of Metropolitan Municipality to ensure their contribution to the sustainability of the project.
